

JHCA - HOME DISTRICT CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES PARTICIPATION

Seacoast Classical Academy recognizes the value of co-curricular activities that are offered by a scholar's home district. Per NH RSA 193:1-c, co-curricular "shall include those activities which are designed to supplement and enrich regular academic programs of study, provide opportunities for social development, and encourage participation in clubs, athletics, performing groups and service to school and community." For the purposes of this policy, "home district" shall refer to the school district in which the Seacoast Classical Academy scholar or pupil resides.

Understanding that these activities are conducted at home district locations soon after the conclusion of the home districts' school day, Seacoast Classical Academy accommodates participation for scholars in grade six and above by scheduling a study hall, or its equivalent, in the final academic block of its school day on at least four of the five days in a typical school week. This accommodation will allow scholars the opportunity to be dismissed early so that they can participate in their home district co-curricular activities.

In order for Seacoast Classical Academy to dismiss individual scholars early for co-curricular activities, the family must inform SCA by submitting the appropriate form reflecting the activity and pick-up times. In the event that early dismissal causes lessons to be missed, it is the responsibility of the scholar and family to make timely arrangements to obtain and complete the materials necessary in order to meet academic expectations.

This policy will go into effect on November 1, 2024. It will be communicated to families of enrolled scholars on or before October 10, 2024. The Academy's website, FAQs, and Handbook(s) will be updated on or before October 24, 2024.
